

PIXLR Assignment Checklist

1. First, you will need to think plan out what you want your image to look like. This will help guide your web search.
2. Use a search engine to search up images. Remember Mr. Swan's demo; search for images that are larger than 800 pixels high and wide. You can resize them in PIXLR later.
3. Search, download and save at least three separate images to use for your file.
4. Import your three separate images into PIXLR as three different layers and then you may begin creating your design.
5. Arrange your layers as necessary to make the design you planned out in step one.
6. Make sure to experiment with the following tools. You may use more; however, you need to use all the following tools:
 - a. Lasso Tool
 - b. Move Tool
 - c. Eraser Tool
 - d. Free Transform Tool
 - e. Text Tool
 - f. Image Size Tool
7. Save your file as a PXD (firstname.lastname_pixlr.pxd) file and then upload your file to CTLS.
