PIXLR Assignment Checklist

- 1. First, you will need to think <u>plan</u> out what you want your image to look like. This will help guide your web search.
- 2. Use a <u>search engine</u> to search up images. Remember Mr. Swan's demo; search for images that are larger than 800 pixels high and wide. You can <u>resize</u> them in PIXLR later.
- 3. Search, download and save at least three separate images to use for your file.
- 4. Import your three separate images into PIXLR as <u>three different</u> <u>layers</u> and then you may begin creating your design.
- 5. <u>Arrange your layers</u> as necessary to make the design you planned out in step one.
- 6. Make sure to experiment with the following tools. You may use more; however, you need to use all the following tools:
 - a. Lasso Tool
 - b. Move Tool
 - c. Eraser Tool
 - d. Free Transform Tool
 - e. Text Tool
 - f. Image Size Tool
- 7. <u>Save</u> your file as a PXD (firstname.lastname_pixlr.pxd) file and then upload your file to <u>CTLS</u>.
